Colorado Telecommunications Surcharge Information

The information below provides details on the telecommunication surcharges administered by the Colorado Public Utilities Commission effective January 1, 2024. More detailed information can be found on the Colorado Telecom Surcharge Page.

Telecom Surcharge Registration

- → Pursuant to 4 C.C.R. 723-2-2827 (a) (III) and 723-2-2150 (c), all voice service providers and providers of 9-1-1 access connections must register with the Commission within 30 days of operating in the State of Colorado.
- → Until 12/31/2023: The Combined Colorado Telecommunications Surcharge Registration Form should be completed and filed via e-filings. An e-filings filer registration account can be created on the Commission's e-filings page. The form is available on the PUC Surcharge Page.
- → Effective 1/1/2024: The Commission will provide a new combined Company Contact Form to be completed and filed via e-filings.

Telecom Surcharge Payment Remittance

- → For the remainder of 2023, access line counts must be remitted monthly using the Combined Colorado Telecommunications Surcharge Remittance Form via e-filings.
- → Effective 1/1/2024: Access line counts must be remitted monthly using our online remittance form in Rolka Loube's online portal.
- → Use the appropriate remittance time period in which the surcharges were collected from the customer, as the rates are built into the form. 2023 and prior year forms can be found on the <u>PUC Surcharge Page</u>. The 2024 form will be released in January.
- → Payment must be remitted to the listed address via paper check or via ACH to the appropriate account. Online ACH payments will be accepted starting in January 2024.
- → Check payments must be accompanied by a paper copy of the completed return.
- → Surcharge remittance details can be found on the Payment Remittance Page.
